Karen Petree discussed her recent attendance at the citizen's academy.

Chief Connally provided his update on crime statistics. Apart from aggravated assaults crime is down. Aggravated assault numbers are overwhelming driven by domestic assaults at this time. Chief Connally provided an update regarding the addition of a second Community Mental Health Liaison to provide coverage in the evening hours. Chief Connally gave an update on CAP's project to respond to homeless individuals and panhandlers. We added two new neighborhood watch groups (Hidden

Valley and Northridge). The Chief informed the committee of our upcoming youth camp and youth academy. Our most recently planned helicopter operation was canceled due to weather.


