



## SMOKE DETECTOR PLACEMENT

Place on the ceiling or wall outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of bedrooms.

In each room used for sleeping purposes

On each story within a dwelling unit, including basements, but not including crawl spaces and uninhabitable attics.

In attached garage.

In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, a smoke detector installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.

## CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR PLACEMENT

Place outside rooms used for sleeping purposes in non-electric homes (homes that have gas appliances, furnace...) Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide detectors may be used in non-electric homes.
