OPENING REPORTS

- A. Roll Call of Voting Members: A quorum was present. Chairperson, Jake Fisher called the meeting to order at 10:30 am.
- B. Approval of Minutes from November 17, 2022 meeting: Abe Forney motioned to approve the November 17th meeting minutes. Chance Gallagher seconded the motion. Meeting minutes for November 17, 2022 were **unanimously approved**.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. TIP Amendment 3: One amendment is the changing of a start date for a repaving project from 2023 to 2024. Two new projects have also been added, first is an intersection turn lane for Herzog funded half by Herzog and half by a Governors Cost Share Grant. The second project is the Pickett Road and AG expansion reconstruction project, shared by the City and Buchanan County also being funded by the Governors Cost Share Grant. Chance Gallagher motioned to approve TIP Amendment 3 and Abe Forney seconded the motion. The motion to approve TIP Amendment 3 was **unanimously approved**.

- B. MoDOT Safety Targets:** All of these targets are not tied to any financial measures, just goals set. Max gave a summary of MoDOTs Safety Targets, the goal for 2023 is 894 or less fatalities statewide. The ultimate target is to get to 0 fatalities by 2030 and 0 serious injuries by 2040. Julius Rice motioned to approve MoDOTs Safety Targets and Abe Forney seconded. MoDOTs Safety Targets were **unanimously approved.**
- C. MoDOT Bridge/ Pavement Targets:** A list of percentages of bridges, interstates and non-interstate pavements in good condition and poor condition. Chance Gallagher motioned to approve MoDOTs Bridge/ Pavement Targets and Julius Rice seconded. MoDOTs Bridge/ Pavement Targets were **unanimously approved.**
- D. MoDOT System Performance Targets:** A list of percentages for travel time reliability measures for interstate and non-interstate travel and freight liability measures. Abe Forney motioned to approve MoDOTs System Performance Targets and Kim Eaton seconded the motion. MoDOTs System performance Targets were **unanimously approved.**
- E. KDOT Safety Targets:** Max explained KDOTs safety targets for number of fatalities, fatalities per 100M vehicle miles travelled, number of serious injuries, serious injuries per 100M vehicle miles travelled and non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries. Julius Rice motioned to approve KDOTs Safety Targets and Chance Gallagher seconded the motion. KDOTs Safety Targets were **unanimously approved.**
- F. St. Joseph Transit Asset Management Targets:** Michelle Shultz gave a summary about Transits targets involving the facilities, equipment and rolling stock. The facilities are all in decent shape for their age. The rolling stock includes a service truck and vans, the service truck will need replaced in the next few years and a van is set to be replaced this year. A majority of buses have been replaced so they have a lot of life left. Kim motioned to approve St. Joseph Transits Asset Management Targets and Abe Forney seconded the motion. F. St. Joseph Transit Asset Management Targets were **unanimously approved.**
