OPENING REPORTS

- A. Roll Call of Voting Members: A quorum was present. Vice-Chairperson, Chance Gallagher called the meeting to order at 10:35 am.
- B. Approval of Minutes from January 26, 2023 meeting: Abe Forney motioned to approve the January 26th meeting minutes and Joshua Stephens seconded the motion. By general consent, the meeting minutes from January 26th were **unanimously approved**.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. 2024-2027 TIP First Look: The Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) is a program and schedule of intended transportation improvements, all Federally funded in the MPO urbanized area for the next four years. The TIP is split into multiple categories of project type; this includes Aviation, Bicycle & Pedestrian Bridge, Bridge, Elderly & Disabled, Highways & Streets, Public Transit, Safety & Hazard Elimination, Freight and Scoping. Although due to inflation, some of the cost estimates for several projects have gone up for the 2024-2027 TIP, such as bridge and re-pavement projects and job order contracting work. **No action needed.**
- B. Proposed Subdivision Requirements: In late April of this year, a proposed revision to the City Code will be presented to Council. The change will require trail dimensions & ADA infrastructure in all new proposed subdivisions. The process will be lengthy, starting with support of the Committees and Council, then to educate developers and implement the new standards and finally overseeing the future trails. The proposed change will be presented to Coordinating Committee and then move onto Council. **No action needed.**

C. Bylaw Revisions: The Bylaws for the Metropolitan Planning Organization has not been updated since December 14, 2006. To better serve the MPO, Technical and Coordinating Committee the laws have been updated with current state codes. Abe Forney motioned to approve the Bylaw Revisions and Julius Rice seconded the motion. By general consent, the Bylaw Revisions were **unanimously approved**.
