The City of St. Joseph has been awarded a \$2.5 million dollar Industrial Site Development grant through the Missouri Department of Economic Development. The grant, funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) will allow for sewer and water loop infrastructure servicing for Phase II of Eastowne Business Park and extends the availability of water to the east for future industrial development.

“Having shovel-ready industrial sites available for business expansion and attraction is critical to the success of our economic development efforts,” said Mayor John Josendale. “Companies looking to relocate seek out communities who have taken the initiative to have sites already prepped to expedite investment and expansion.”

The city appreciates the assistance of Brad Lau, Vice President of Economic Development with the Chamber of Commerce, who worked closely with Chance Gallagher, Deputy Director of Transportation for the Department of Public Works & Transportation, to pursue the grant, and Mosaic Life Care for providing funding for the grant writer.
