OPENING REPORTS

- A. Roll Call. A quorum was present for the Technical Committee. Julius Rice called the Technical meeting to order.
- B. Approve minutes of September 21, 2023 meeting. Chance Gallagher motioned to approve the minutes and Abe Forney seconded. With general consent the prior meeting minutes were **unanimously approved.**
- C. Roll Call. A quorum was present for the Coordinating Committee. Ron Hook called the Coordinating meeting to order.
- D. Approve minutes of June 15, 2023 meeting. Marty Novak motioned to approve the minutes and Madison Davis seconded. With general consent the prior meeting minutes were **unanimously approved.**

NEW BUSINESS

- A. **TIP Amendment:** The City has requested to add three (3) projects in the Public Transit section of the TIP and remove three (3) projects. Projects being added are automatic passenger counting software, a van for supervisors, and a sand trap oil separator. The City's projects being removed are the zero emissions bus, additional deviation routes on Saturdays and evenings, and the MPO Coordinated Human Services Plan. MoDOT has requested to add the pavement resurfacing of I-29 project to the Highway and Streets section of the TIP. This section of interstate will be from Pigeon Creek to the Platte County line near Faucett. Madison Davis motioned to approve the TIP Amendment and Marty Novak seconded the motion. By general consent, the TIP Amendment was **unanimously approved.**
- B. **HDR Multi-Modal Corridor Presentation:** Christopher Kinzel and Taylor McHenry with HDR, presented to the Technical and Coordinating Committee a brief overview of the Multimodal Corridor Planning Study and what the next steps will be. So far, tasks to be completed are data collection, two visioning sessions with at the Stakeholder meetings and four developed economic scenarios. The four scenarios include a no build/ control scenario, airport development, freight/ rail/ airport/ port development and a large-scale development. HDR is asking for approval from the Committees to move forward with the scenarios, then will have another Stakeholder meeting to present the infrastructure improvements and share the Economic Assessment results. Madison Davis made the motion to move forward with the four scenarios and Marty Novak seconded the motion. By general consent, the motion was **unanimously approved.**
