City Councilmember Taylor Crouse's resignation from the City Council has created a vacancy in District II that will be filled as soon as possible.

The City Charter requires applicants to be qualified voters in the city, and residents of the city for at least one year immediately prior to any appointment to office. As this is a district appointment, residents must reside within the district at least six months immediately prior to any appointment. In addition, no person in arrears for any city taxes shall be eligible to hold this office.

The City Council is asking interested persons who meet the established criteria to submit a letter of intent and resume to the City Clerk's office before 5pm, on Friday, March 29, 2024. The letter of intent and resume must be hand delivered to Room 303, City Hall, 1100 Frederick Avenue.

All submissions will be reviewed by the City Council at a work session to be scheduled for April 1. Dependent on the number of submissions, a pre-determined number of candidates will be subsequently interviewed. The mandatory interviews will take place on Thursday, April 4, in the Council Chamber. City Council will vote on the candidate to fill the vacancy at a Special Council meeting to be held on Tuesday, April 9. The appointed person will be sworn in prior to the April 15 City Council meeting.
