- A. Metropolitan Transportation Plan Presentation and Discussion: Jim Meyers with AECOM presented the Technical and Coordinating Committee with the 2050 Project update. The update included the project schedule, 2045 MTP needs, existing conditions, and potential multimodal projects. This MTP Project Plan will be adopted in November 2024. Discussions included roadway/freight needs, transit needs, and bike/ped needs. Safety conditions were also discussed, Jim explained about fatality and serious injury crashes, crash densities, crash types, bike/ped safety and the traffic volume that ties to these statistics. Cook Road and US 169 Intersection was discussed to be added as a potential project if it hasn't been added previously.
