At least 2 working days, not including holiday and weekends, prior to when any and all excavation work is to commence, the Permittee shall notify the following: **MISSOURI ONE-CALL at 811**. Permittee is liable for any damages to franchised or public utilities, private utilities, or other infrastructure damage due to failure to first contact utility owners.
